

Solid Waste/ General Services

- Five solid waste equipment operators won national and state awards for driving skills while competing in events sponsored by the Solid Waste Association of North America (SWANA). This training and competition helps develop driving skills that enhance efficiency and safety.
- The solid waste department achieved 97% excellent or good ratings for residential solid waste collection.
- Increased roll-off fleet by one additional vehicle (total of six) to meet customer demand and achieve approximately 50% market share.
- Support for neighborhood clean-ups and other in-kind service totaling \$15,400 in labor, equipment, and disposal of materials collected.
- Completed construction/renovation of the Beach Visitors Information Center and Beach Police Substation.
- Completed renovations of the Customer Services Lobby at the Municipal Services Building, the Harborview Center atrium, and the Police Special Operations vehicle parking area.
- Standardized the purchase of construction equipment and heavy-duty trucks to reduce parts support, tool requirements, and to concentrate training efforts.
- Maintained 1.36 million square feet of buildings, an increase of 160,000 square feet over Fiscal Year 2002.
- In-house parts ordering and distribution saved the city more than \$300,000.
