

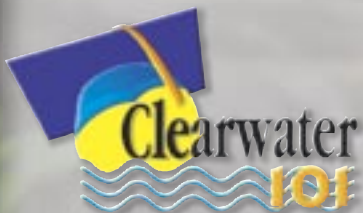
Getting Involved
