- Facilitated the redevelopment of an unsafe house and junkyard into two affordable homes in the North Greenwood neighborhood using Brownfields funds.
- Completed first phase of Clearwater Homeless Intervention Project transitional housing with opening of Parkbrooke Apartments.
- Clearwater Police Department retained the only AmeriCorps program in Pinellas County law enforcement agencies, and implemented an operational "Ambassador" program in the downtown and beach areas.
- Partnered with African American Leadership Council, Inc. at Martin Luther King Recreation Center, and Boys & Girls Clubs, Inc. at Wood Valley Recreation Center, to provide programs for youth.
- Nationally recognized as an All America City finalist for Hispanic Outreach Center, North Greenwood Apartments project, and the Library READ program to prevent high school dropouts among high risk youth.
- Partnered with the Clearwater Neighborhoods Coalition to host the 2004 Neighborhood Conference. More than 110 residents and 12 teens from diverse areas of the city participated.
